

Children and Young People's Training Team

The Team provides training to staff working within Wiltshire for Children and Young People with complex health care needs, free of charge, when working with a Wiltshire Child.

The training is available for all staff employed by statutory and/non statutory and/or voluntary organisations. The training is attended by staff from schools, social services, transport services, family link carers, holiday play schemes, short breaks providers and early years or settings..

This programme is run to meet the needs of staff new to caring for children and young people with complex health care needs and for those who require annual updating to maintain competency:

CLINICAL SKILLS THEORY WORKSHOPS

The Clinical Theory Days are organized in sessions. Staff will only need to attend the individual session(s) that are relevant to the child(ren) they provide care for.

Clinical Skills Sessions:

- **Seizure Management:** for staff working with a child who has **seizures** for which rescue medication (**Buccal Midazolam**) has been prescribed, this includes theory and competence.
- **Enteral Feeding:** for staff working with a child who has a **gastrostomy button or PEG** used to administer feeds/medications, this includes theory.
- **Severe Allergy Training:** for staff working with a child who has a severe allergy for which an EpiPen/injector has been prescribed, this includes theory and competency.

INDUCTION COURSES

Staff providing 1:1 support for a child/young person with **complex healthcare needs** will need to attend an induction course before starting their training with the individual child. This provides them with the background skills and knowledge needed to provide safe care to a child/ young person with complex health care needs.

The induction takes place over 3 full days and includes:

- An introduction to caring for a child with complex health care needs,
- Seizure management with administration of rescue medication,
- Gastrostomy feeding,
- Professional accountability / record keeping
- Maintaining a safe environment,
- The third day concentrates on the respiratory needs of children with complex health care needs. This includes respiratory assessment, oral suction, saturation monitoring and administration of oxygen and an introduction to caring for a child with a tracheostomy.

PLEASE NOTE: Participants **MUST** be available to attend the entirety of the course.

Please discuss the need to attend an induction course with the child/ young person's Community Children's Nurse or a member of the training and development team.
